2026 Summer Enrichment Program INCOME QUALIFICATION WORKSHEET

Program Fees

Unless eligible for exemption as listed below, each child will be charged a fee of \$30/week.

The following groups of citizens with appropriate documentation will be exempt from the fees and will be able to register for the Summer Enrichment Program at no charge.

- Foster Parents;
- Unemployed parents or guardians;
- Families or guardians on Family Independence Program (FIP);
- Families or guardians on Food Stamps (FS);
- Families or guardians on Supplemental Security Income (SSI);
- Families or guardians on Medicaid;
- Families or guardians on Federal Housing or Section 8 Assistance;
- Families or guardians on Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) Program;
- Families or guardians on Aide to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC);
- Families or guardians with or below the following income levels:

Program Weeks:

- Week #1 June 8 - June 12, 2026
- Week #2 June 15 - June 18, 2026 (June 19th is a City Holiday; No program)
- Week #3 June 22 - June 26, 2026
- Week #4 June 29 - July 2, 2026 (July 3rd is a City Holiday; No program)
- Week #5 July 6 - July 10, 2026
- Week #6 July 13 - July 17, 2026
- Week #7 July 20 - July 24, 2026
- Week #8 July 27 - July 31, 2026
- Week #9 August 3 - August 7, 2026

To be eligible for a refund, cancellations must be requested before the beginning of each week.

Additional Program Notes:

- Youth participants may be suspended from the program after 3 late pick-up. Fifteen (15) minutes after the program ends for the day constitutes a late pick.
- Failure to pick up youth participant 1 hour after the program ends will necessitate reporting the infraction to Children Protective Services (CPS)
- Parent/Guardian orientation is mandatory for program participation.
- Verification of youth participant's age may be required.
